Membership Requirements: Membership is easy. All members of the National Railway Historical Society are required to maintain their membership in good standing by paying their annual dues and to abide by the Bylaws of the organization, local and national. Family Friendly Membership

For a nominal additional fee, the other members of your family can become NRHS Members too. Student & Youth Membership

Annual Membership Dues/Fees

National Society plus Chapter dues are \$46.00 per year for Membership. A member of your family may also join for an additional \$6.00 per year. Student memberships are just \$26.00 per year. Youth memberships are just \$15.00 per year.

Memberships run from January 1 - December 31st. New members joining after September 1 receive membership for the current year plus all the next following year at the regular price. Memberships not renewed by March 31 are cancelled.
